One part of the Course Fee is for loans or maintenance of camera, textbooks, PE uniforms, Calculator, etc. The other part will be used for consumables or items that cannot be reused such as write-on course books, paint, films, fabrics, or portfolio paper, etc. in Art or Technology classes, or cost for class trips.

Guardianship Fee

It is compulsory for a student to have a local guardian. As well as for the regular daily based care and 24 hours' on-call service, this guardianship fee is also to be used for bringing students to see the doctor or counselor, bringing / dropping students for personal travel trips, and other contingencies.

Part IV. Fee Protection

As the signatory to the Code of Practice, we have set out International Student Fee Protection Policy. Student tuition fees are regarded as a liability until they have been used. They are banked into a separately coded account and are downloaded one term in arrears. Western Springs College preserves international student tuition and homestay fees paid in advance so that they can be accessed in the event of the College's closing, or in the event that the College becomes unable to offer or to continue a course of programme to students.

Part V. Home Stay information

All International Students enrolled at Western Springs College are required to live in English speaking Homestay accommodation, which is arranged and supervised by the college. This is seen as an appropriate environment for students to learn not only the English language but also New Zealand customs and culture. If a student wishes to live in accommodation that has not been arranged by the college, a special application must be lodged. The College should make the final decision about the student's homestay placement according to their assessment of the family nominated by the student's parents.
